

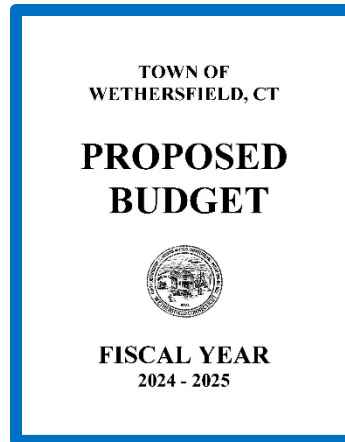

A reminder that if you haven't ordered your brown yard waste barrel yet; do so soon! The yard waste collection program started last week and the response has been excellent. The first order of 700 brown barrels sold out in the first week. But don't fret, more will be arriving soon and everyone that wishes to purchase one will get that opportunity. The new yard waste collection program is an important part of our efforts to reduce our waste stream. Separating yard waste from the green trash barrels greatly reduces the volume of trash sent to regional trash facilities and reduces the amount of methane gas released into the atmosphere. It's a great way for Wethersfield residents to contribute to Wethersfield's environmental sustainability efforts. The program runs the first full week of April through the last full week of November. The program will not replace the fall leaf collection program. Residents may purchase a 95-gallon brown barrel for yard waste. The brown barrel cost is \$98.64. Call Paine's Inc. at (860) 844-3000 to order a brown barrel. Payment with a credit card or check prior to barrel delivery is required. This is a one-time fee and the resident then owns the barrel and is able to take it with them should they move. Initial limit of 1 barrel per household. Alternatively, residents can utilize the 30-gal compostable lawn and leaf bags that they can purchase from any hardware or home improvement store. Yard waste collection will be on the same day as your current recycling pick up (every other week). A reminder that yard waste is not allowed in the green, blue or pink bins and this will be strictly enforced moving forward. Do your part to help us reduce our environmental impact!

ENGINEERING

- **Great Meadow Rd & Marsh St Trail:** VHB is currently completing preliminary design of new multi-use trails along Great Meadow Rd and Marsh St to connect the Putnam Bridge trail to Main St in Old Wethersfield. We anticipate the trail will follow a new concrete curb to be installed along the edge of Great Meadow Rd and will primarily be located off of Marsh St within state on town rights-of-way. **A Public Information Meeting for this project will be held on Thursday May 2nd at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers of Town Hall.** Preliminary plans showing the proposed trail alignment will be presented, and representatives from the Town and VHB will be present to solicit feedback and answer questions. The Town has been awarded \$2.3M in state LOTCIP funding for these two phases of construction, which at this time are expected to start in 2025. Please contact the Engineering Department at 860-721-2850 or engineering@wethersfieldct.gov if you cannot attend the meeting and have questions regarding the project.
- **Temporary Great Meadow Rd & Hart St Trail:** At this time, the state plans to open the Putnam Bridge Trail in mid-May. Until permanent trails can be constructed, the Town will be providing a temporary trail along Great Meadow Rd and Hart St to provide a safer bicyclist and pedestrian connection between the bridge trail and Main St. Our contractor is scheduled to complete temporary pavement overlay in limited areas along these roads next week, which will be followed by revisions to pavement markings that will allow for installing a 12" wide yellow stripe with placement of moveable, vertical delineators to create a trail along the sides of the roads. The temporary trail will be 10' wide in most areas, except for the east-west segment of Hart St where the trail will only be 5' to 6' wide due to the limited road width. As part of this work, a temporary crosswalk with a new stop bar and signs will also be installed along Great Meadow Rd at the Burbank Rd intersection.
- **Cove Park Trail Improvements:** The Town has been awarded \$95,000 in DEEP Recreational Trails Grant funding to complete design of trail improvements through Cove Park and parking lot reconstruction behind the Solomon Welles House, which requires a 20% match from the Town. With the addition of a new Civil Engineer in the Engineering Dept, the Town will be completing the design in-house to reduce the Town's cost and the state funds will be reallocated towards the cost of construction. Once the trail is designed, the Town plans to submit an application for additional construction funding from this program.
- **Wolcott Hill Rd Reconstruction Project:** Town staff has developed a plan to install concrete planters and vertical delineators at the north end of the island located near the Hartford city limit to help protect a new "Welcome" sign that will be installed, and the replacement of two streetlights that were recently hit by a vehicle and damaged. These safety improvements will be installed by the Physical Svcs Dept in the coming weeks.
- **DOT Putnam Bridge Rehabilitation (State Project No. 0053-0199):** DOT held a virtual public meeting for residents of Wethersfield and Glastonbury last week to discuss their upcoming bridge rehabilitation project. The project will address water leaks through the concrete bridge deck and associated corrosion of the steel substructure with construction expected to occur in 2026-2027. Since Great Meadow Rd will be used again for construction storage areas, DOT has agreed to reconstruct the road upon completion of this project.
- **Sidewalk Repairs:** All property owners are reminded that per the Town Ordinance, owners of land fronting upon any street are responsible to replace, repair or otherwise correct defects in any sidewalk located within the public

right-of-way adjacent to their property. Staff will be inspecting sidewalks along roads to be paved and other areas throughout Town. If you receive a notice to repair a sidewalk and have questions, or if you encounter any sidewalk safety concern, please contact the Engineering Department at 860-721-2850 or engineering@wethersfieldct.gov.

The Town has a Residential Sidewalk Assistance Program to complete sidewalk repairs and replacements within the right-of-way to eliminate safety hazards that is available to residential property owners who have a demonstrated financial need for assistance. Funds are available on a first-come, first-serve basis until expended. Please contact the Engineering Department or the Social and Youth Services Department at 860-721-2880 for additional information.

- **CNG Griswold Rd Gas Main Improvements:** CNG's contractor is currently installing new gas mains within the Griswold Rd right-of-way. The alignment will impact existing sidewalks in this area, which will temporarily be restored with bituminous walks that will later be replaced with concrete. Please use caution when traveling through this area during construction.
- **Spring Paving Program:** Town crews are currently replacing catch basin tops and sidewalk ramps, and at this time, we anticipate that General Paving will start paving preparation work next week with Tilcon starting milling operations in late-April. 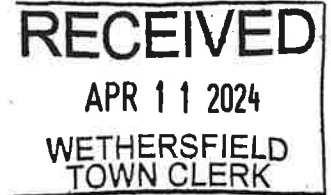
